

The Natural Resources Wales collaborative agreement with the River Restoration Centre and what it means for Natural Resources Wales staff



This agreement is being funded to help support the delivery of solutions working with natural processes. Advice is available to all NRW staff and the service will be managed and monitored to ensure sufficient time is allocated across departments. Larger initiatives and projects can produce further advice and support at the agreed NRW rates.

All Natural Resources Wales staff are members of the River Restoration Centre.

What is the River Restoration Centre (RRC)?

- Independent, not for profit UK advisory and information centre which promotes, facilitates and supports best practice in river, watercourse and floodplain restoration and management
- The RRC is not a project or design consultancy and it does not bid or competitively tender for work. For that reason a collaborative agreement with Natural Resources Wales has existed since its inception in 2013.
