What's going on at the European River Restoration Centre?

Informally constituted as a specialist's river restoration network in 1999, ECRR's main activity was to promote sustainable river and floodplain management and to ensure widespread implementation and dissemination of river-floodplain restoration activities, through developing a European Network of relevant river restoration institutions. Nowadays, ECRR is a formal association of 16 such institutions and with a network of thousands river restoration practitioners promoting and building capacity for ecological river restoration across greater Europe. ECRR is supporting the implementation of the EU Water Framework Directive, Flood Directive, the UNECE Water Convention, the Convention on Biodiversity, as well as national policies in wider Europe.
