2021 RRC ANNUAL NETWORK CONFERENCE ABSTRACT SUBMISSION DEADLINE EXTENDED

Due to the ongoing uncertainty of opening face-to-face venues, the RRC 2021 Conference is being planned as a hybrid event. The booking for the DoubleTree by Hilton Harrogate Majestic Hotel currently remains, however we are also working with the venue to be flexible on dates and format. With the rise in local restrictions and the current limit of 30 people for venue-based meetings in place until March 2021, we have been in talks with the DoubleTree by Hilton Harrogate Majestic Hotel to move the date of next year's conference from April to October 21st & 22nd.
