Join us in Scotland on November 7th 2023, to visit Rottal Burn in the South Esk Catchment. Rottal Burn was re-meandered in 2012. During the project 1200m of new channel plus backwaters was created, connection to wetlands was established, and 2000 native trees were planted. Ten years on we will hear about this ambitious project that won the 2023 UK River Prize, for the 'reach-scale award'.
