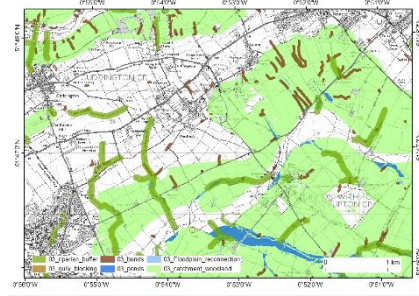
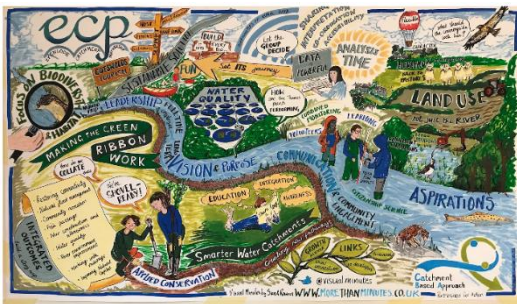

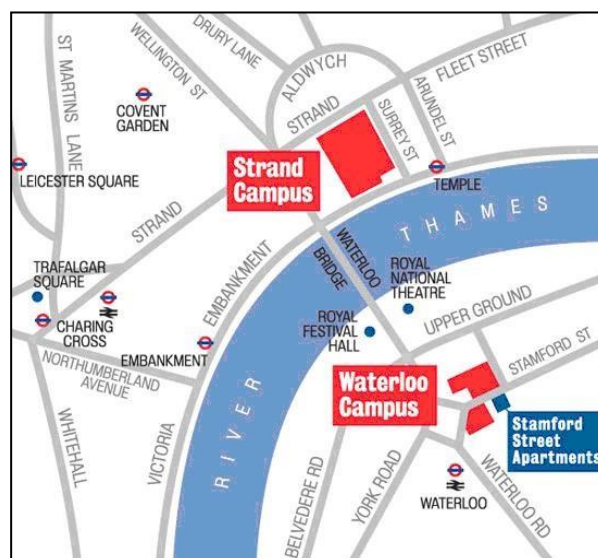
LOCATION
