**‘Back from Blackwater to Brazil’**  
*Applying UK lessons from restoring the River  
Blackwater with natural processes to Brazil*  
**Carolina Pinto Ultimos Refugios Institute Brazil**

Carolina Pinto will describe her pioneering partnership work with large wood enhancing the River Blackwater, Surrey and how this is helping an urban river back from the dead into one of the best Thames tributaries. She will outline a 6 year Queen Mary University London academic partnership, evaluating effects of wood on habitats, flood risk, plants, invertebrates and fish. We will hear how this partnership led to the first Loddon Rivers Week in 2012 and an innovation award for the first river restoration in Espirito Santo, Project ReNaturalize in the River Mangaraí, Tropical Atlantic Forest in Brazil. Carolina invites you to discuss community led approaches vital for beneficial sustainable stewardship, enhancing local environments and cost effective and targeted river maintenance in the UK and Brazil.

This inspiring talk is open to all and suitable for flood and asset managers, operations teams, local authorities, river restoration practitioners, flood action groups, catchment partnerships among others interested in sustainable catchment management. Find out more:
